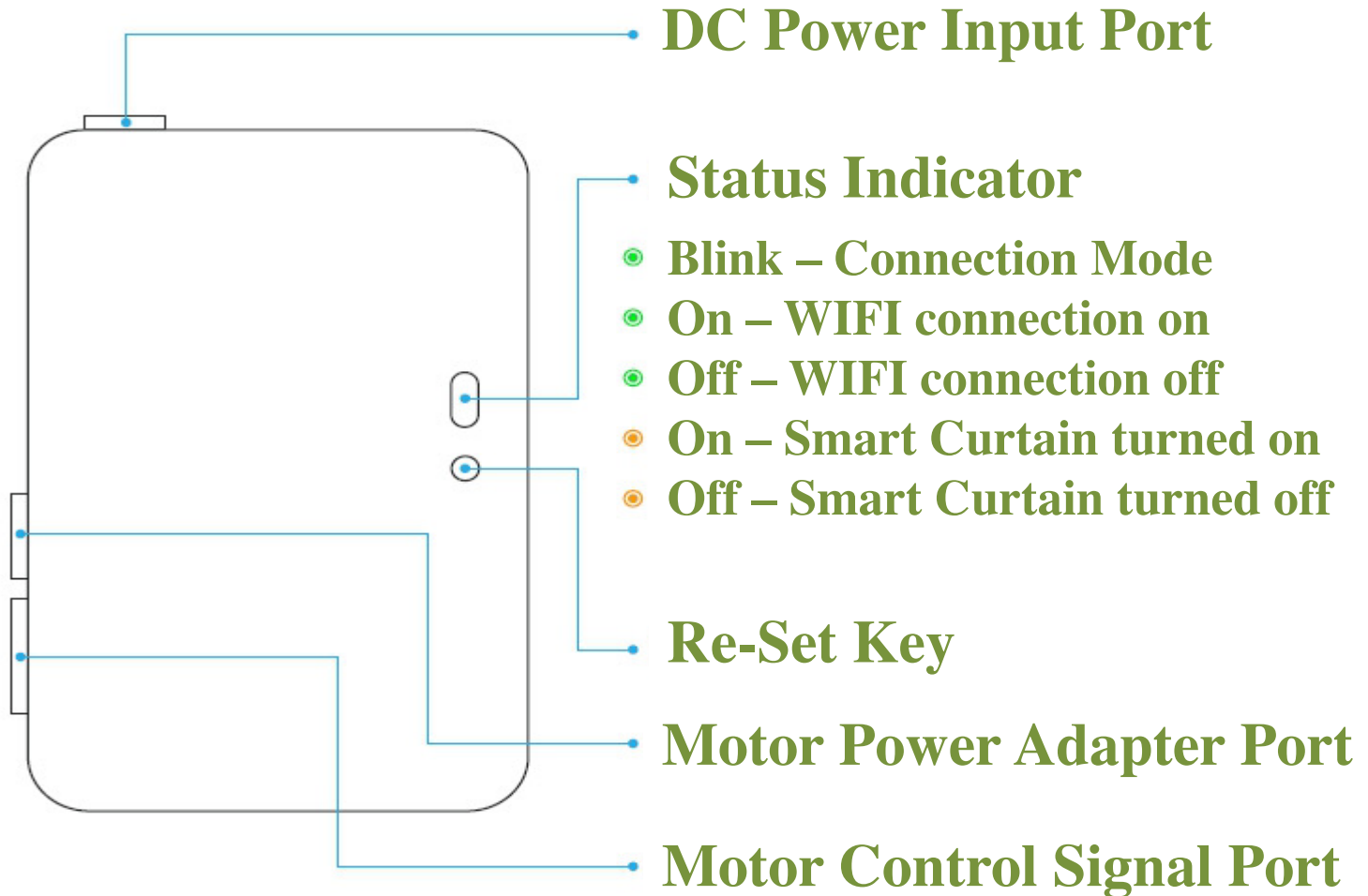

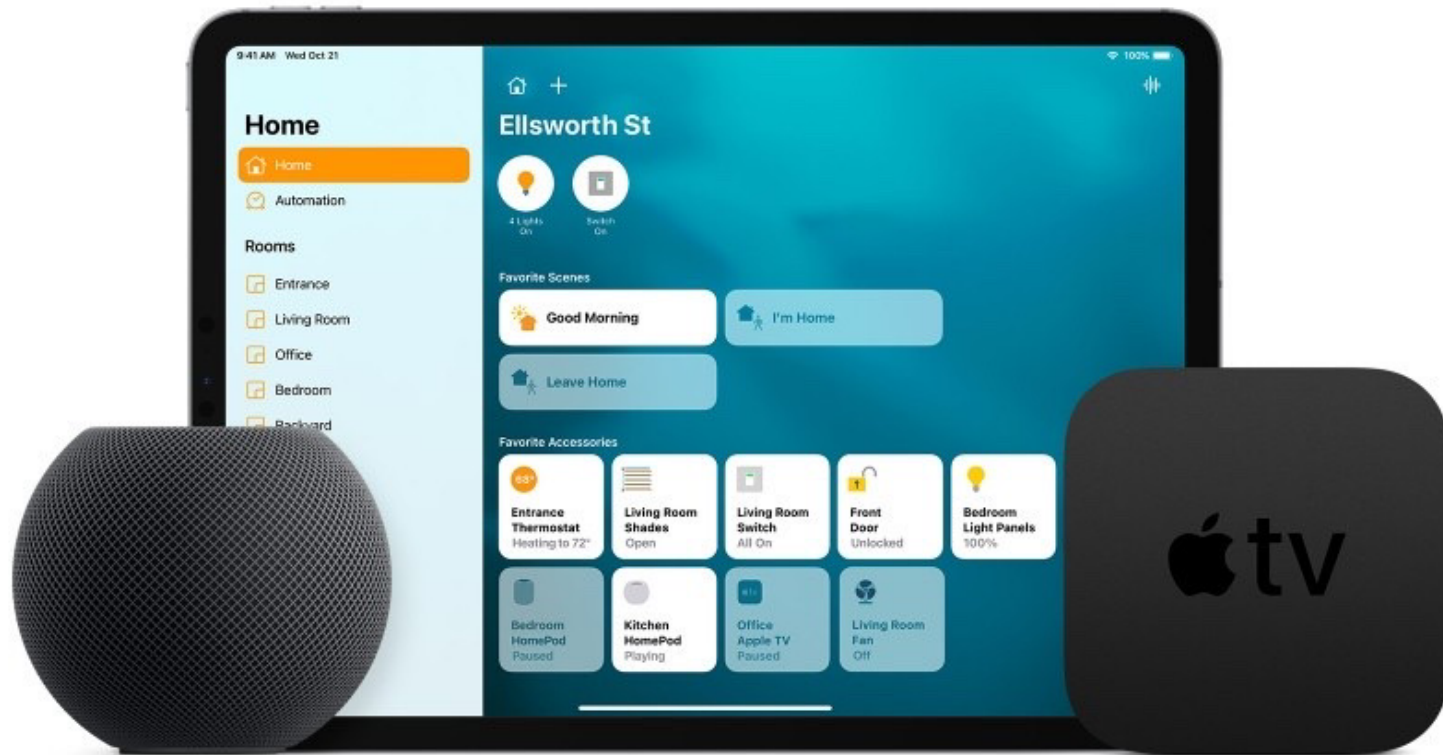


# HomeKit

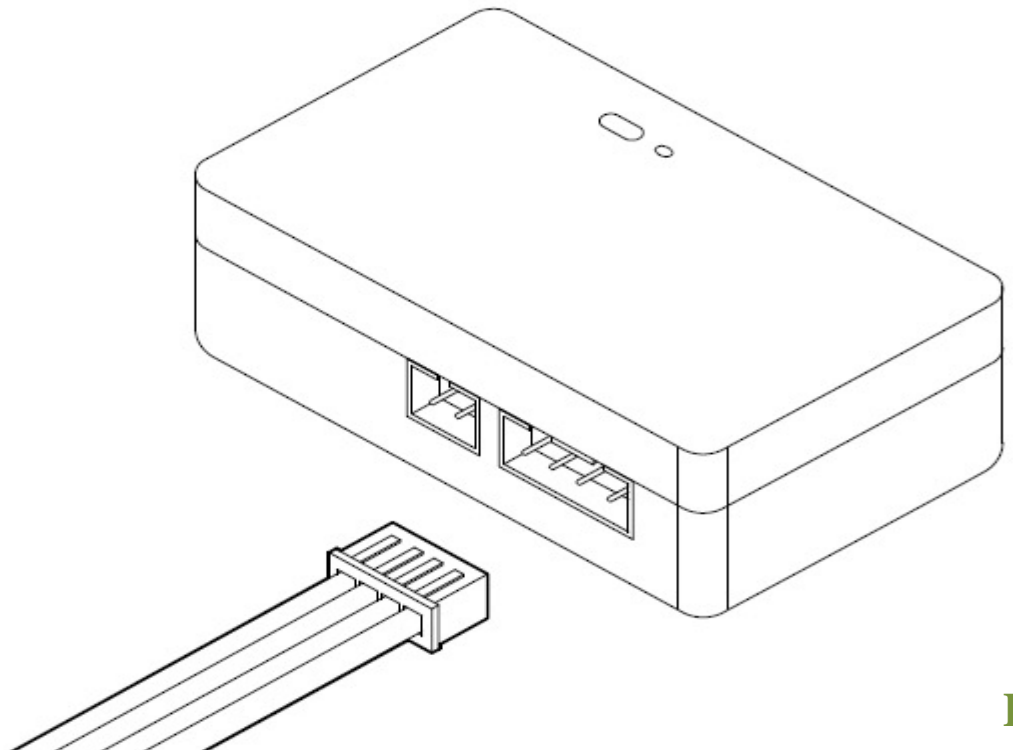

connected to [control] port.

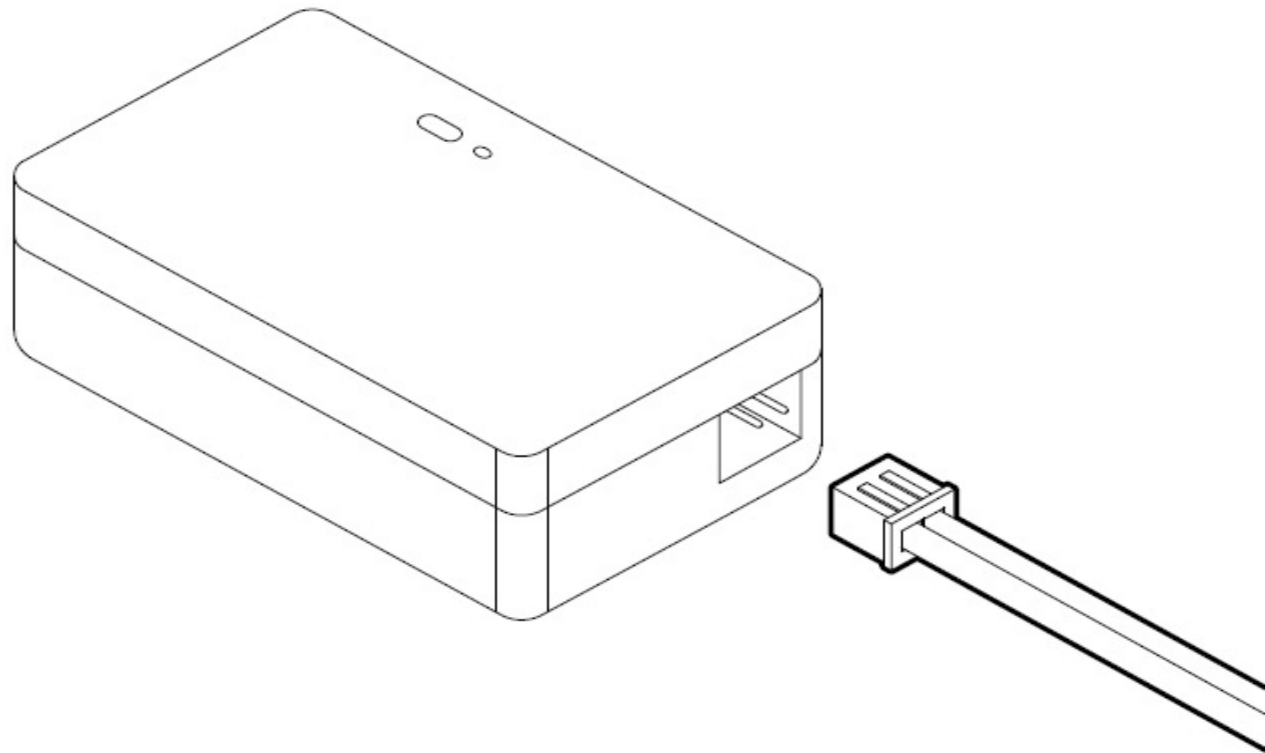

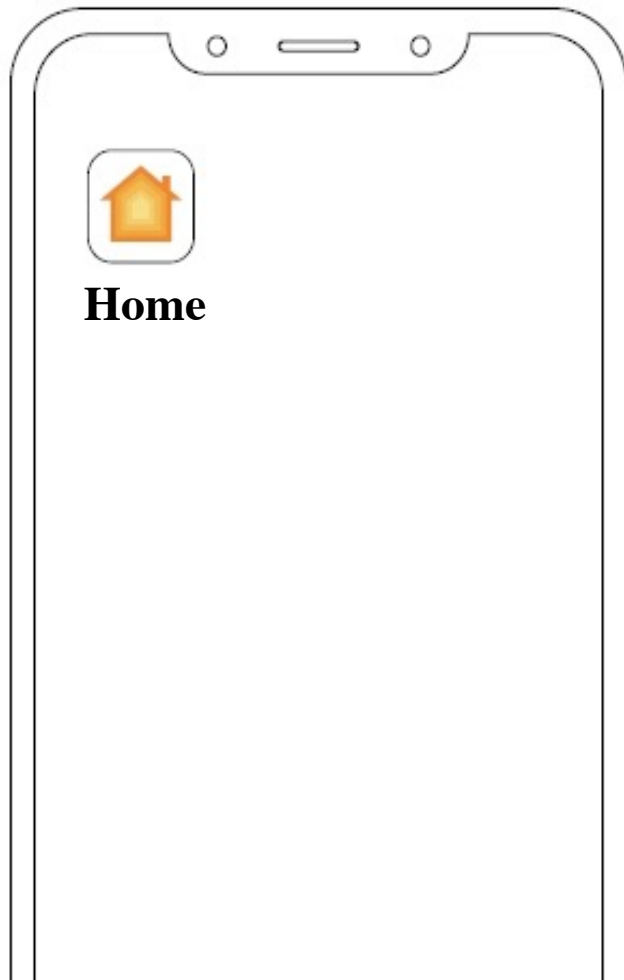
### Smart Curtain connection to Control Box: Step (2)

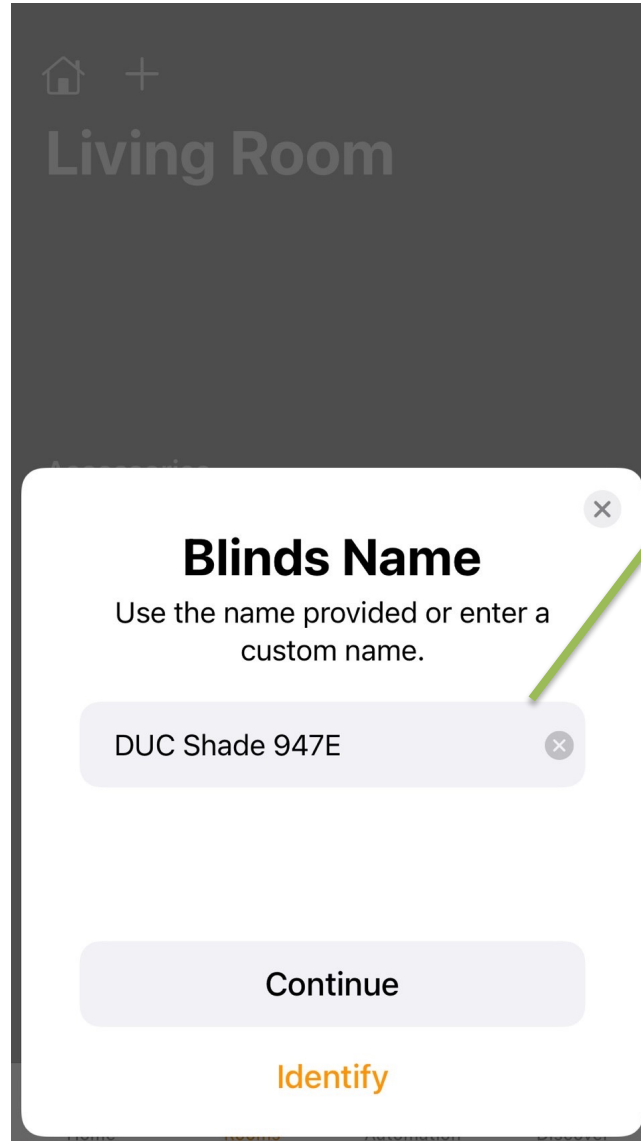

## Change the name and other settings



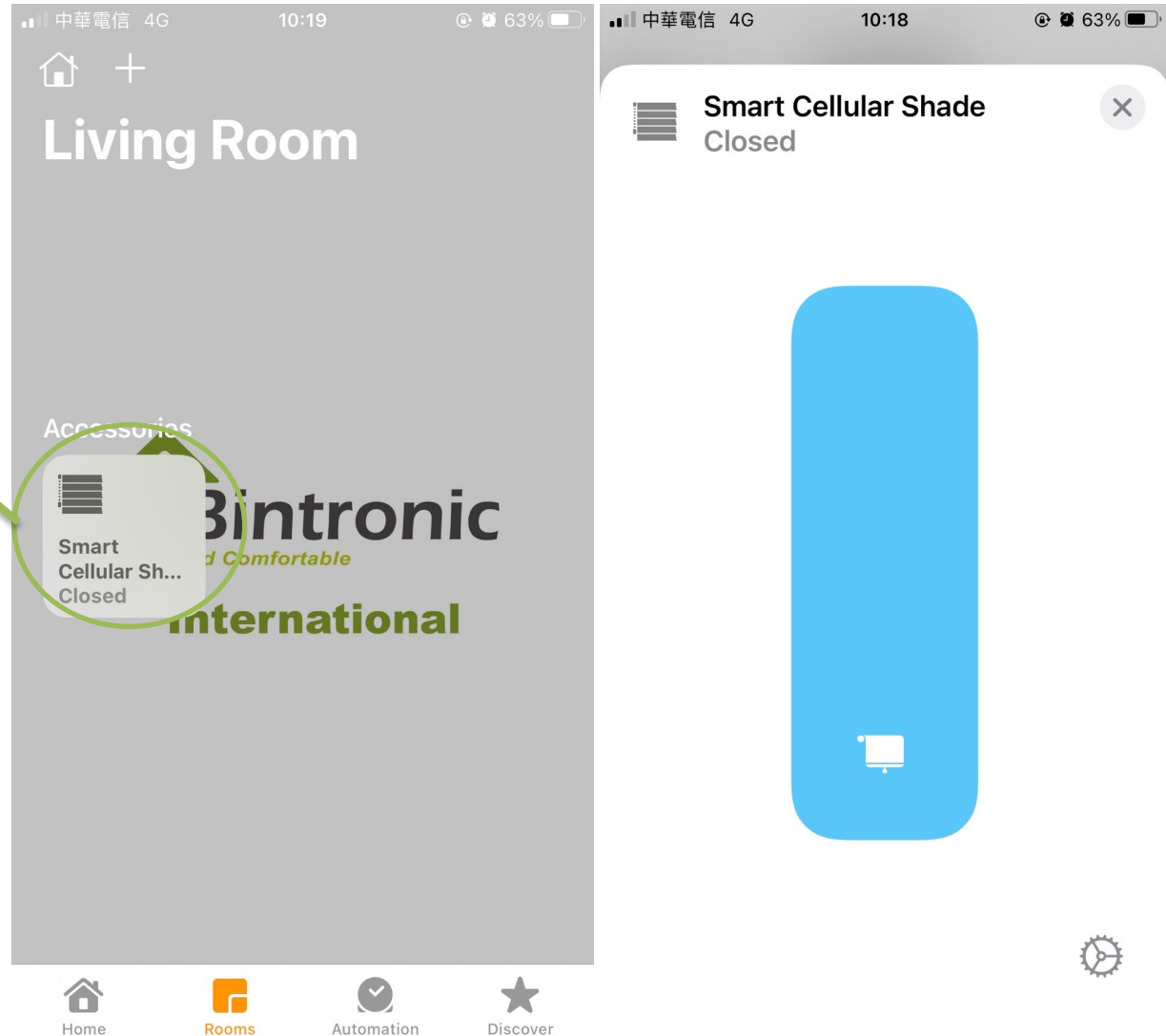
Change the name to “Smart Drape” or “Smart Roller Shade.”

Click on Device to open or close it.

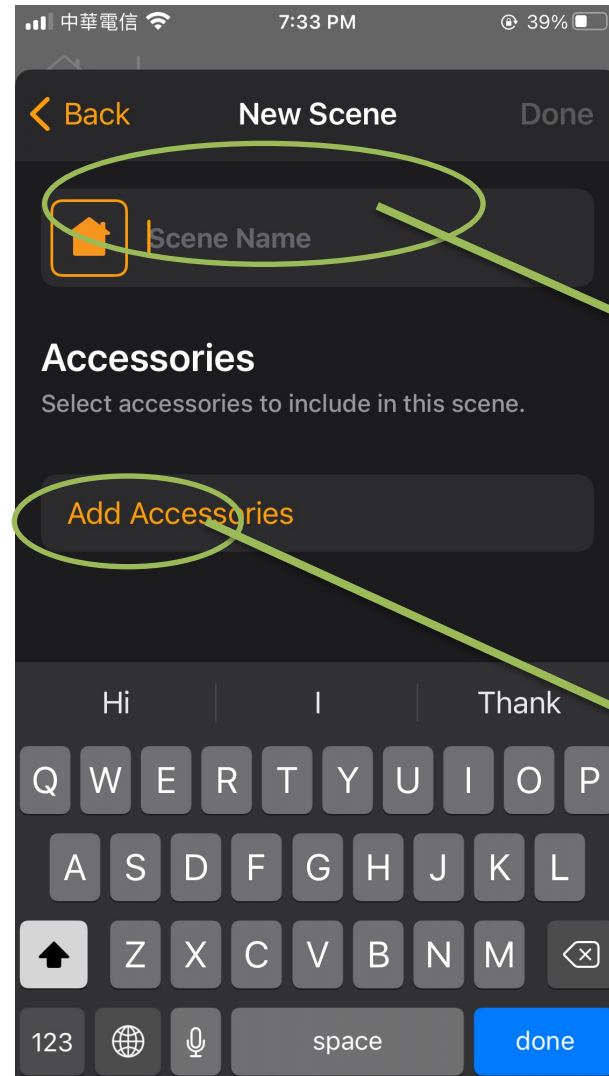
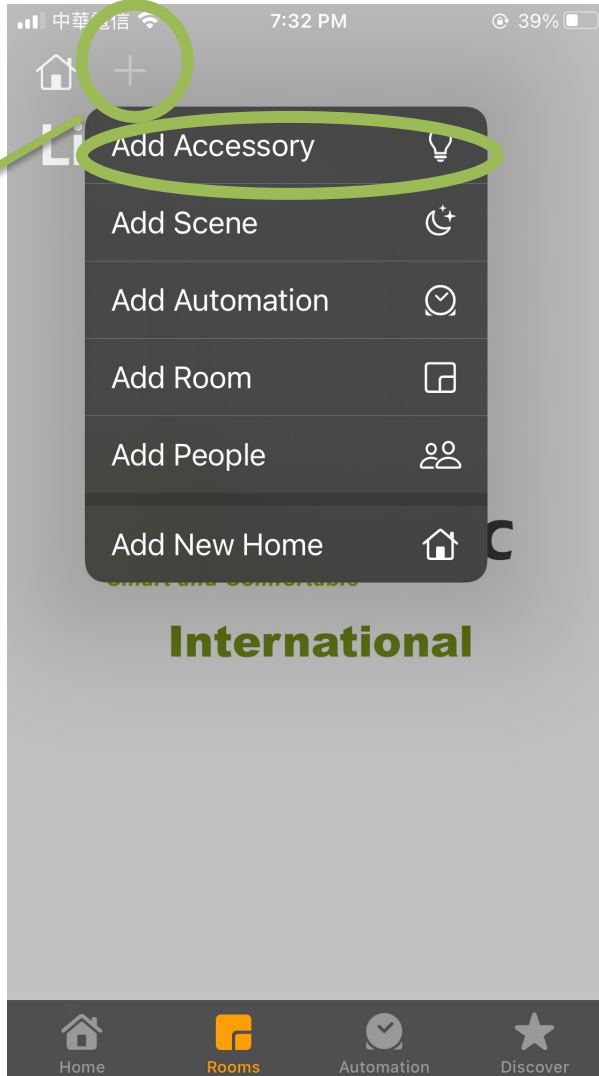
Press and hold Device to enter the percentage mode.

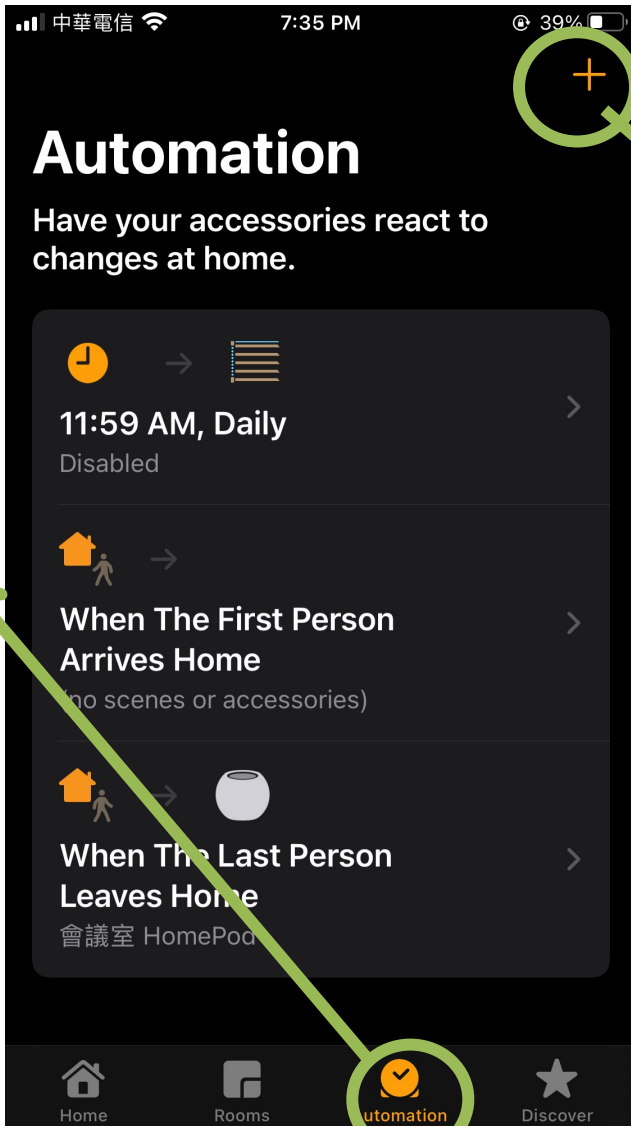

# HomeKit Re-setting

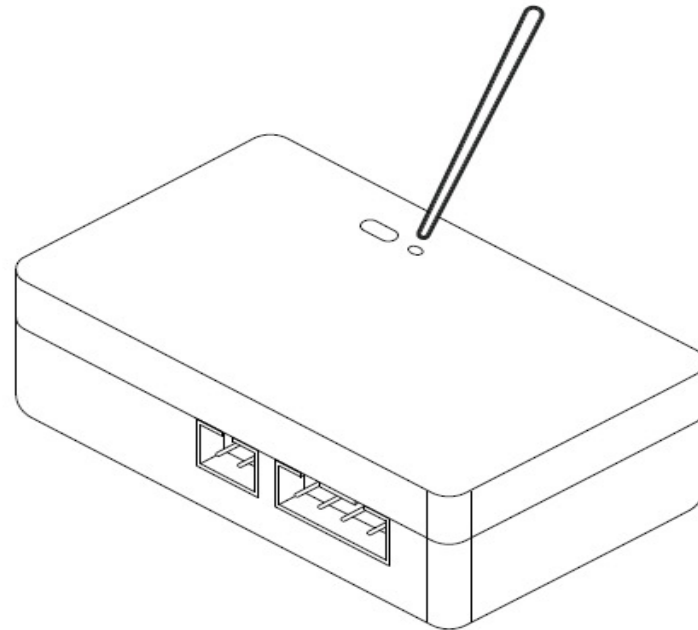
## Re-set Procedures

1. Delete Device from APP
2. Press and hold Re-set button

Use a paper clip to gently press the [Re-set] button next to the indicator for about 10 seconds; you may re-set your Smart Curtain when the green LED blinks quickly and goes out for approximately 1 second.

**This shall be done in  
Power ON condition.**

3. Re-scan to add it in.





# HomeKit Troubleshooting

## Simple Troubleshooting

1. Shut off smart curtain and control box for 30 seconds and re-start them.
2. Shut off WIFI router for 30 seconds and re-start it.
3. Re-start Home Hub and iPhone.
4. Re-set control box and re-scan to add it in.
